

NOTICE UNDER THE CITY'S PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY ACCESS AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT TRANSITION PLAN

ANNUAL OUTREACH MEETING

In accordance with the requirements of Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 ("ADA") and Title 24, the City of Moreno Valley adopted an Americans with Disabilities Act Transition Plan in 1995. As an extension to the 1995 Transition Plan, the City adopted the Public Right Of Way Access (PROWA) Americans with Disabilities Act Transition Plan on September 14, 2010. A component of the Transition Plan includes the implementation of a Community Outreach Program, designed to seek input from the public regarding the City's ongoing barrier removal efforts for pedestrians within the City's public rights of way. The City will be hosting an Outreach Meeting to seek public input on the identification of new and existing barriers and to inform the public of the City's compliance accomplishments and plans. This outreach meeting is open to the public and will include discussion on the following infrastructures within the public right of way:

- Access Ramps
- Sidewalks
- Traffic Signal Equipment
- Other Types of Barriers within the ROW

There will be a continuous Power Point presentation to provide an overview of the City's PROWA Transition Plan, construction activities over the past year and proposed activities for the next year. City Staff will be present to answer questions.
