City Manager Henry Garcia has appointed Ahmad Ansari as the City's Public Works Director/City Engineer. Ansari was selected after an open and competitive recruitment and will oversee the Capital Projects, Electric Utility, Special Districts, Maintenance and Operations, and Traffic Engineering Divisions of the City.

Ansari has 11 years of executive level experience, including 6 years as Public Works Director for the cities of Rialto and Perris. He has also served the cities of Pomona and Burbank as Deputy Public Works Director and Senior Civil Engineer respectively. Regarding the appointment, Garcia said "Ahmad's extensive experience with all aspects of public works is a huge plus for us and his familiarity with our region means he will hit the ground running at all levels. I had the pleasure of working closely with Ahmad previously and know him to be a hard-working, extremely productive manager in whom I have the highest regard and confidence.
