The Master Plan of Trails connects neighborhoods, parks, and regional destinations like Lake Perris and Box Springs Regional Park, offering 56+ miles of scenic paths for walking, jogging, biking, and horseback riding.

### TRAIL ETIQUETTE

#### **LET'S KEEP OUR TRAILS SAFE, CLEAN, AND ENJOYABLE FOR EVERYONE.**

**Pedestrians** – Stay alert, share the trail, and watch for cyclists and horses.

**Cyclists** – Ride single file, yield to others, use a bell or say "On your left," and always wear a helmet.

**Equestrians** – Communicate with others and help teach trail courtesy.



### TRAIL RULES

1. Keep right and don't block the trail.
2. Travel at safe speeds; slower users have the right of way.
3. Keep dogs on leash and clean up after them.
4. Use caution at road crossings and obey all signs.
5. Announce yourself or use a bell when passing.
6. Approach horses calmly and speak to the rider.
7. Avoid trails during muddy or soft conditions.
8. Trails are non-motorized only. Report violations:

9. Leave trails as you find them. No littering or new paths.
10. Report graffiti: 951.413.3171 (24-hour hotline)

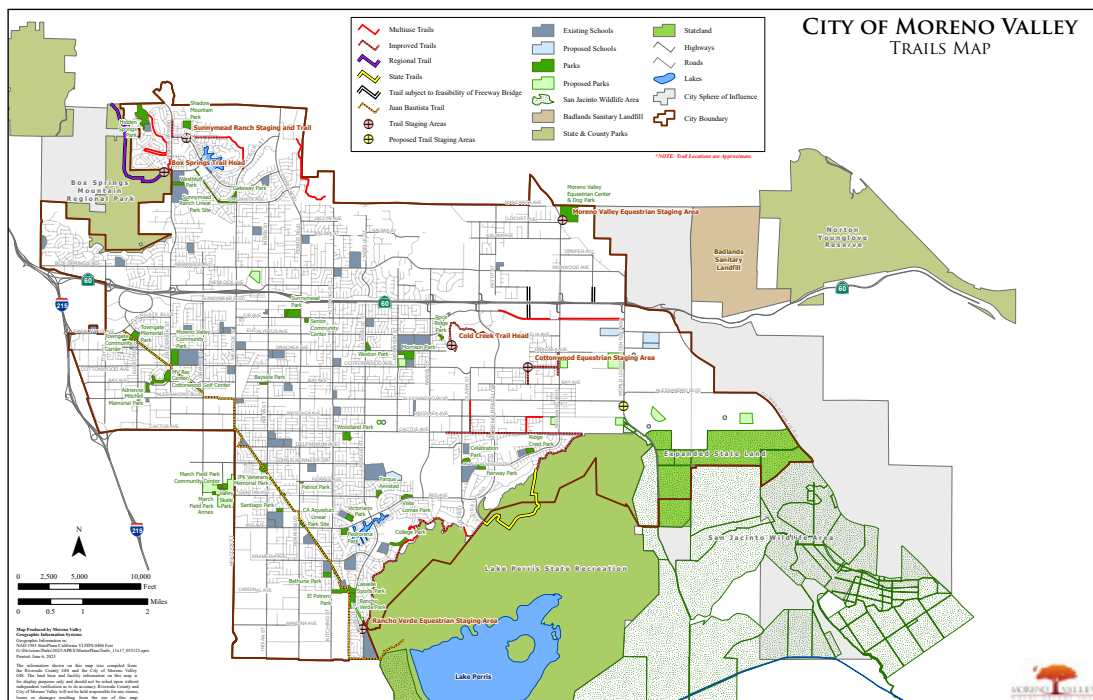
