## **HOW TO BECOME A VOLUNTEER**

Apply at the Moreno Valley Police Department, Community Services Unit, located at 22850 Calle San Juan de Los Lagos, Moreno Valley or call (951) 486-6717.

### **Programs:**

#### **Anti-Graffiti Patrol (AGP):**

Trained citizen volunteers to assist in surveillance, reporting, and apprehension of graffiti vandals.



#### **Citizens Patrol (CP):**

Trained neighborhood patrol units consisting of citizen volunteers. They are a deterrent to crime by being highly visible while patrolling shopping centers, neighborhoods, or targeted problem areas.

#### **Station Volunteers:**

Assist various entities at the police station. They help with filing, tracking of offenders, and putting together "mug shot" folders. Assist with Neighborhood Watch presentations, work with special-interest and business groups, assist with inputting information into computers, and fingerprinting.

**Anti-Graffiti Patrol (AGP), Citizen Patrol (CP), and Station Volunteers must be at least 18 years of age.**

#### **Explorer Program:**

A program for the Youth of Moreno Valley. Applicants must be between the ages of 14½ years and 21 years of age. The Explorer Program teaches responsibility, leadership skills, and discipline. The Explorers are active in various community functions and assist different units of the MVPD

**Volunteers are required to donate a minimum of 12 hours per month.**
