### **BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION**

The City of Moreno Valley, in collaboration with Moreno Valley Adult School, continues to expand access to workforce development and educational resources through the Business & Employment Resource Center (BERC). Moreno Valley Adult School is a valued partner, providing accessible, no-cost, and low-cost programs designed to support residents in achieving their education and career goals.

Through this partnership, individuals receive guidance and training in areas such as high school diploma completion, English as a Second Language (ESL), career technical education, and job readiness skills. Moreno Valley Adult School staff work directly with participants to identify their goals, remove barriers to success, and create clear pathways to employment and continued education. This collaboration strengthens the City's ability to deliver comprehensive, community-centered services that support workforce readiness, economic mobility, and long-term success for Moreno Valley residents.
